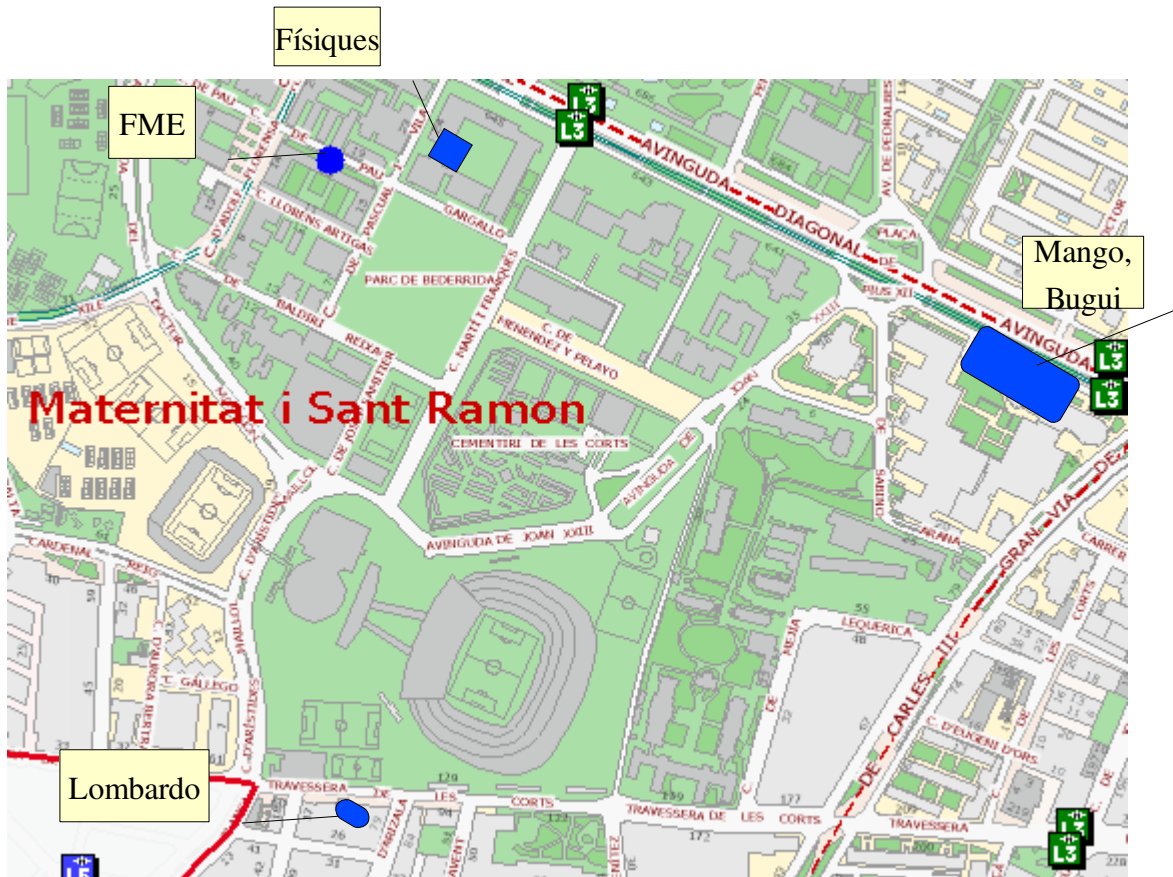

### Eating close to FME:



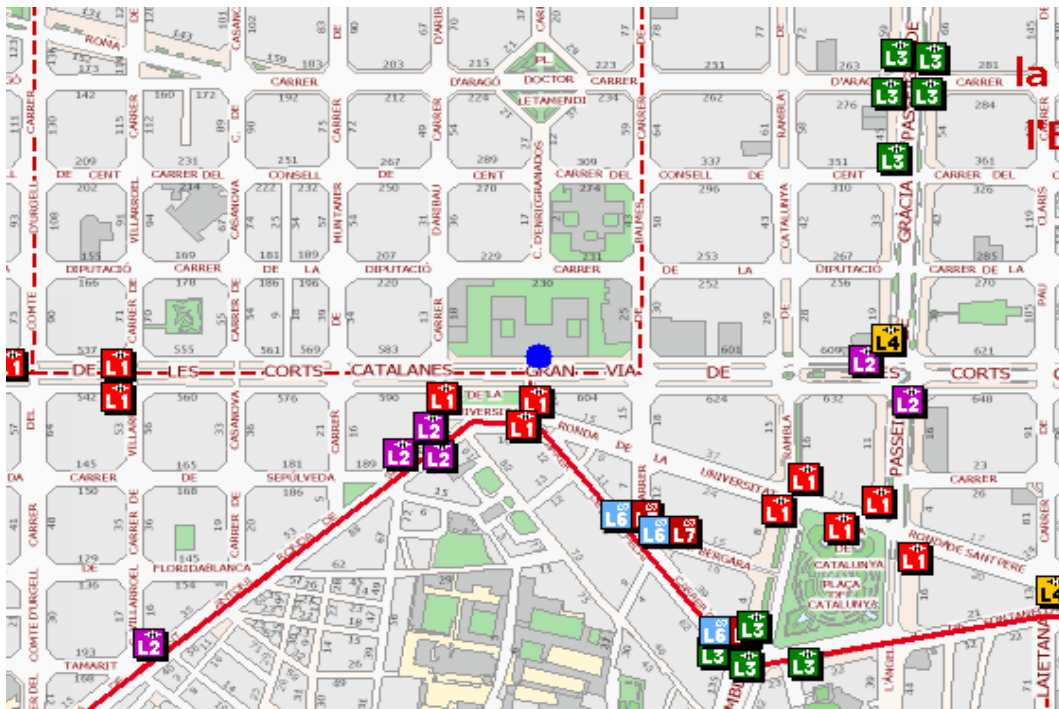
You can eat also at the bar of FME, which is not really bad.

At "Físiques" they offer a salad buffet and then pizzas and second course for about 6,50€.

At the other restaurants the menu is about 10€.

At "Campus Nord" of UPC (close to the residence Torre Girona) there are many places to eat and a good restaurant called "Notable".

Going from FME to Facultat de Matemàtiques, University of Barcelona (UB), Gran Vaia 656:



You can take the metro line L3 at "Palau Reial" and transfer to line L2 in Paral·lel, and then get off at "Universitat". This takes about 35 minutes.

The other option is to stay on line L3 and get off in Catalunya. Then walk all Pelai Street up to Plaça Universitat. This takes about 40 minutes.

The colloquium will take place at the ground floor of the Mathematics "patio" (entrance on the right of main door), room B6.
